Dear Senator Cortez Masto, Senator Durbin, Senator Menendez, Senator Luján, and Senator Padilla:

Thank you for your letter dated May 31, 2023, to the Director of the Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR), seeking to make cancellation of removal available to noncitizens who are not in removal proceedings. Executive Order 12866 requires the annual production of a Unified Regulatory Agenda and Regulatory Plan (Unified Agenda) to provide public notice and transparency about proposed regulatory actions within the Executive Branch. The current Unified Agenda does not include a proposed regulation to expand access to cancellation of removal relief; however, EOIR will certainly consider this suggestion for future rulemaking.
