FY2024 Community Project Funding for Nevada

Senator Rosen and Senator Cortez Masto requested funding for projects in their communities to be included in the FY2024 minibus funding agreement. The funding awarded to Nevada projects is listed below by subcommittee.

Agriculture, Rural Development: (5 total)

Nye County – Amargosa Library – \$750,000

Nye County will use this funding to add additional square footage to the existing Amargosa Valley library.

Duckwater Shoshone Tribe – Community Building – \$512,000

These funds will help support the Duckwater Shoshone Tribe's community center used for recreational, educational, social, and support services.

<u>Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Elko Band – Indian View Heights Road</u> Reconstruction – \$940,000

The Tribe will use these funds to reconstruct and improve Indian View Heights, the main arterial roadway of the Elko Indian Colony.

Storey County – McCarran Sheriff's Office – \$450,000

Storey County will relocate the County Sheriff's Office substation to the Storey County Government Complex located in McCarran.

Douglas County – Smelter Creek Tributary Flood Control – \$55,000

This funding will support a preliminary detention basin study in order to alleviate downstream flooding impacts.

Commerce, Justice, and Science: (12 total)

<u>Desert Research Institute (DRI) – Planning for the Future at Lake Tahoe –</u> \$3,000,000

DRI will use this funding for research focused on sustainable recreation and long-term planning at Lake Tahoe.

City of Ely – Security Cameras and Public Safety – \$610,000

The City of Ely will install security cameras at the City of Ely's facilities and public parks to increase public safety in the community.

<u>City of Sparks – Police Security and Officer Safety – \$520,000</u>

The Sparks Police headquarters will use this funding to install new security equipment, cameras, and motion detector systems to improve officer safety.

City of North Las Vegas – Public Safety – \$1,620,000

This request will fund the replacement of outdated police technology and vehicles for the North Las Vegas Police Department.

City of Reno – Police Department Wellness Initiatives – \$1,500,000

The City of Reno will use this funding to support peer mentor mental health and wellness initiatives within the Reno Police Department.

<u>Clark County – Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Recruitment –</u> <u>\$800,000</u>

These funds will help expand recruitment efforts for CASA volunteers.

Lander County – Crime Prevention Technology – \$563,000

Lander County will purchase technology and equipment to support crime investigation, response, and prevention activities.

<u>Reno Sparks Indian Colony – Law Enforcement Equipment – \$265,000</u> These funds will help Reno Sparks Indian Colony police officers upgrade to equipment and patrol vehicles.

Washoe County – Forensics and Rapid DNA – \$996,000

The Reno Police Department, Sparks Police Department, and the Washoe County Sheriff's Office will use these funds to purchase of Rapid DNA instruments as part of a pilot program.

Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department – Emergency Command Vehicle Replacement – \$1,000,000

This community project request will help purchase a replacement of an Emergency Command Vehicle to respond to large-scale emergencies.

<u>City of Henderson – Public Safety Officer Wellness – \$782,000</u> This funding will expand the City of Henderson's wellness program for public safety professionals.

<u>University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Tectonic Measurement – \$982,000</u>

This project will fund the acquisition of analytical equipment for standardized tectonic measurement and to better support geoscience research.

Energy and Water Development: (2 total)

<u>Desert Research Institute (DRI) – Lithium Resource Mapping – \$1,63,000</u> This funding will support a comprehensive geologic mapping and study project on lithium resources and recovery in Nevada.

<u>Bureau of Reclamation – Las Vegas Wash – \$4,100,00</u> The Bureau of Reclamation will construct erosion control structures along the Las Vegas Wash within the boundaries of the Lake Mead National Recreation Area.

Financial Services and General Government: (2 total)

<u>Nevada Secretary of State – State Business License Online Portal - \$4,000,000</u> The State Business License Online Portal project will improve the state's online business portal, helping the tens of thousands of business owners in Nevada and driving more business to the state.

<u>Winnemucca Indian Colony – Small Business Incubator - \$1,338,000</u> The Small Business Incubator project will help design and construct a small business incubator to house and support new start-up businesses.

Homeland Security: (2 total)

<u>Clark County – Rural Fire Station Emergency Generators - \$588,572</u>

The Rural Fire Station Emergency Generators project will fund the installation of emergency generators around rural fire stations in Bunkerville and Searchlight. This project will allow fire stations to continue to operate and provide emergency services for the communities during natural disasters.

City of Reno – Swan Lake Irrigation Pipeline - \$2,869,000

The Swan Lake Irrigation Pipeline project will move underground an existing 5mile water pipeline to improve flood resiliency.

Interior and Environment: (15 total)

<u>Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe – Water Tank Replacement – \$186,000</u> This request will fund the construction a new water storage tank.

<u>Te-Moak Tribe of Western Shoshone, Battle Mountain Band – Water and Sewer</u> <u>Lines – \$2,000,000</u>

This funding will help the Tribe replace the existing, outdated water lines and sewer lines.

<u>Walker River Paiute Tribe – Water Storage Tank Improvements – \$1,360,000</u> The Walker River Paiute Tribe will use this funding to purchase a new water storage tank and repair of an existing water storage tank.

<u>City of Ely – Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Project – \$4,820,000</u> Ely will upgrade their water treatment plant with new equipment to address and correct deficiencies.

City of Reno – Sewer Upgrades – \$3,000,000

The City of Reno will install new sewer mains in the McCloud neighborhood and connect them to the City of Reno sewer mains.

<u>City of Carlin – Arthur Spring Main Water Line Replacement – \$602,000</u> This funding will help replace 3,500 feet of the water transmission main pipeline in Carlin.

<u>City of West Wendover – 3 Mile Reservoir Rehabilitation – \$209,000</u> This funding will be used to rehabilitate the 3 Mile Reservoir, a 1.5-million-gallon enclosed drinking water storage facility located within the Goshute Valley.

<u>Reno-Sparks Indian Colony – Cultural Resources Preservation – \$161,000</u> The Reno-Sparks Indian Colony's Cultural Resources Program and Tribal Historic Preservation Office building in Reno will use this funding to make renovations.

<u>Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe – Numana Dam Fish Screen – \$2,870,000</u> This funding will help install a new fish screen and a pipe fixture at the head works of the Numana Dam to prevent fish from entering water diverted for irrigation.

<u>Humboldt County – Grass Valley Waste Water Treatment Facility – \$2,750,000</u> Humboldt County will use this funding to completes the design and engineering for a new wastewater treatment system in Grass Valley.

<u>Storey County – Gold Hill Collection System – \$2,500,000</u>

Storey County will replace the existing gravity sewer collection system in the community of Gold Hill.

Washoe County – Stormwater Management – \$1,930,000

This project will realign portions of Bailey Creek Park's drainage infrastructure to improve hydraulic flow, armoring, and utility relocation.

Lyon County – Grosh Water Main – \$2,580,000

This funding will help Lyon County design and replace of a water distribution main located on Grosh Avenue in Dayton.

<u>Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) – Septic Conversation Phase One and</u> <u>Two – \$960,000</u>

SNWA will use these funds to connect Las Vegas homes currently utilizing septic systems to the public sewer system.

<u>Southern Nevada Water Authority – Septic Conversation Phase Two – \$960,000</u> SNWA will use these funds to connect Las Vegas homes currently utilizing septic systems to the public sewer system.

Labor, HHS, and Education: (20 total)

Clark County – Community Paramedic Program Expansion - \$535,000

The Community Paramedic Program Expansion project will provide the Clark County Fire Department with funding for vehicles, equipment, and salaries for paramedics for a Community Paramedic Program to help serve those in need of services outside of the 911 system.

Clark County - Foster Care Caregiver Recruitment - \$949,000

The Foster Care Caregiver Recruitment program will increase the Clark County Department of Family Services' (DFS) outreach and recruitment of caregivers for foster children, and provide supportive resources for foster placement families.

<u>Clark County – Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program - \$942,000</u> The Medication-Assisted Treatment program will bring medical services, medication, counseling, and referral planning services to the county's detention facilities to reduce overdose deaths and help reduce recidivism rates to support public safety.

<u>Clark County – Mental Health Training for Firefighters, Law Enforcement, and</u> <u>First Responders - \$934,000</u>

The Mental Health Training for Firefighters, Law Enforcement, and First Responders project will provide mental health training for over 6,700 professional first responders.

<u>College of Southern Nevada – Nursing Simulation Lab - \$2,300,000</u>

The Nursing Simulation Lab project will upgrade the current lab space in the health and sciences building on the Henderson Campus to enhance the ability for the College of Southern Nevada to educate and train individuals to become registered nurses.

Desert Research Institute – Environmental Studies – \$1,800,000

The Environmental Studies project will fund instruments to study environmental pollutants in Nevada and to educate students to work with innovative analytical instrumentation at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas and University of Nevada, Reno.

Desert Research Institute – K-12 STEM Education Pathways - \$2,800,000

The K-12 STEM Education Pathways project will support STEM education and workforce development. Desert Research Institute will develop computer science education for K-8 students, programming and mentorship for high school students to help gain workforce experience, and professional development.

<u>Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe – Health Center Equipment Modernization -</u> <u>\$210,000</u>

The Health Center Equipment Modernization project will help provide high quality health care services for Tribal members by replacing medical, dental, and pharmaceutical equipment that is outdated or by providing new equipment that can enhance and/or expand the services provided to patients.

<u>Great Basin College – Native American Health Science Training and</u> <u>Credentialing Program - \$760,000</u>

The Native American Health Science Training and Credentialing Program project will establish reservation-based health science training and credentialing opportunities for Native American students in northern Nevada.

<u>Great Basin College – Workforce Preparedness Training Systems - \$1,422,000</u> The Workforce Preparedness Training Systems project will fund new, state-of-theart training systems that will provide hands-on workforce training to students in the Electrical Systems Technology and Instrumentation Systems Technology programs in Elko, Ely, and Winnemucca.

Lyon County Department of Human Services – Youth Mobile Crisis Response Team - \$673,000

This project will fund the expansion of mobile crisis teams to respond to incidents involving young residents of Lyon County. The response team would include credentialed staff such as a licensed clinical social worker, licensed clinical professional counselor, and a juvenile probation officer.

Lyon County Human Services – Respite Program for Seniors - \$411,000 The Respite Program for Seniors project will fund the creation of a respite program for older adults and individuals living with disabilities in Lyon County.

<u>Nevada State College – Mental Health Workforce Development - \$1,650,000</u>

The Mental Health Workforce Development project will establish degree completion pathways to accompany the non-academic credit programming at the Workforce Development department at Nevada State College.

<u>Nevada State College – Speech-Language Pathologist Educational and Training</u> <u>Opportunities - \$938,000</u>

The Speech-Language Pathologist Educational and Training Opportunities project will expand the number of service and educational opportunities available at the Nevada State Speech Language Clinic (NSSLC) by funding educational opportunities for low- and middle-income students.

<u>University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Nursing Simulation Equipment - \$400,000</u> The project will fund healthcare simulation equipment for the UNLV School of Nursing Clinical Simulation Center of Las Vegas. This will allow UNLV's academic health center to provide additional resources to improve quality of education and thereby improve patient outcomes and patient safety.

<u>University of Nevada, Las Vegas – Supercomputer Upgrades for Instruction and</u> <u>Research - \$4,000,000</u>

The project will fund the purchase of High-Performance Computing (HPC) hardware and software upgrades at UNLV's National Supercomputing Institute. This state-of-the-art technology will enhance computational capacity in support of UNLV's research community.

<u>University of Nevada, Reno – High-Field Nuclear Magnetic Resonance</u> <u>Spectrometer - \$2,406,000</u>

The High-Field Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectrometer project will fund the purchase of a new Nuclear Magnetic Resonance (NMR) spectrometer. The new instrument would allow for the advancement of scientific education, research, and training across the entire state of Nevada.

<u>University of Nevada, Reno – Research and Educational Platform (REP) on Lake</u> <u>Tahoe - \$1,800,000</u>

The project will fund a REP vessel based at the newly acquired UNR at Lake Tahoe campus. The REP will include research-grade environmental monitoring, computing, and visualization technologies that will serve as a living laboratory to move both science & education forward on the waters of Lake Tahoe.

Washoe County School District – Leadership Pathway - \$2,000,000

The project will fund the training, mentorship, and learning opportunities needed to build the capacity of WCSD educators and administrators. This will ensure WCSD will have a pool of prepared leaders in support of academics, operations, and personnel.

Western Nevada College – Douglas Nursing Lab Expansion - \$4,392,000

The Douglas Nursing Lab Expansion will fund the renovation of the science lab and classroom space at the Douglas Campus of Western Nevada College in Minden, Nevada. This expansion will allow students to learn in their own rural community, encouraging them to stay and work in nursing locally.

Military Construction and Veterans Affairs (4 total)

<u>Air Force – Nellis Dormitory – \$7,500,000</u>

This funding will support the design of a 240-room dormitory at Nellis Air Force Base. Future appropriations will be used for construction.

<u>Army National Guard – Combined Support Maintenance Shop – \$2,700,000</u> This funding will support the design of a Combined Support Maintenance Shop in North Las Vegas. Future appropriations will be used for construction.

Army National Guard – Instruction Facility – \$5,490,000

The Army National Guard will design a Regional Training Institute facility in North Las Vegas. Future appropriations will be used for construction.

<u>Army National Guard - Ready Building – \$590,000</u>

This funding will support the design of a Ready Building in Reno for a team of first responders in the event of an attack or emergency. Future appropriations will be used for construction.

Transportation, Housing, and Urban Development: (38 total)

Las Vegas Paiute Tribe – Blight Removal – \$550,000

This funding will support blight removal and landscaping at the entrance to the Tribe's downtown reservation.

City of North Las Vegas - Cheyenne Park - \$6,700,000

The City of North Las Vegas will add safety elements, activity centers, and a park maintenance hub to provide a variety of health benefits to low and moderate-income area residents.

<u>City of West Wendover – Downtown Development and Infrastructure – \$3,700,000</u> This funding will help the City of West Wendover construct a utility and public restroom facility, as well as a community recreation area and splash pad in the city's downtown.

<u>City of Henderson – Navigation Center – \$4,000,000</u>

The City of Henderson will use this funding to acquire a building for a new Navigation Center to serve those experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

<u>City of Fallon – New River Substation Backup Generator – \$3,640,000</u> The City of Fallon will install a generator to provide backup power to the City during extended outages and allow for additional generation during peak periods.

City of Sparks – Oddie Boulevard Community Center – \$4,000,000

This award will help fund building improvements to create a community service center with childcare space, workforce training opportunities, and community meeting spaces.

<u>City of Reno – Rehabilitation for Historic California Building – \$870,000</u> This funding will support renovations to the interior and exterior of the City of Reno's historic California Building.

Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe – Stillwater Senior Center – \$180,000

The Fallon Paiute-Shoshone Tribe will purchase new vehicles and equipment for the Tribe's senior center.

<u>*Reno-Sparks Indian Colony – Sunshine Lane Site Preparation – \$1,620,000*</u> This award will support site clearance to allow for future development of a cultural center and other development within the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony.

<u>Reno Tahoe Airport Authority – Airport Rescue and Firefighting – \$911,000</u> The Reno Tahoe Airport Authority will use this funding to purchase a new Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) vehicle.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) – City of Las Vegas Vision Zero –</u> <u>\$5,000,000</u>

This award will fund pedestrian and bike enhancements, median island modifications, traffic signal and street lighting upgrades, and pavement rehabilitation.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – I-95 Rehabilitation – \$1,000,000</u> NDOT will rehabilitate existing aging pavement and update hydraulic drainage facilities and existing access points onto the roadway.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Lyon County Miller Aiazzi Alignment –</u> <u>\$2,200,000</u>

NDOT will use this funding to rebuild the intersection of Miller Lane and Aiazzi Lane.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Nye County Pogue Paving – \$4,400,000</u> This funding will help pave 13 miles of Pogue Summit Road in Nye County that serves the Duckwater Tribe.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Pyramid Way Project – \$1,000,000</u> This funding will rehabilitate the pavement and upgrade existing ramps, driveways, and sidewalks to make them ADA compliant.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – RTC of SNV Carey Avenue – \$1,920,000</u> NDOT will use this funding to repair and replace damaged and failing asphalt concrete, install new LED streetlights and pedestrian crossings, and relocate utilities in North Las Vegas. <u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Regional Transportation Commission</u> (RTC) Of Washoe Sun Valley Corridor – \$2,500,000

Washoe RTC will use this funding to support pedestrian, bicycle, transit, and traffic safety improvements within the Washoe County corridor.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Tahoe Transportation District, State</u> <u>Route 28 – \$5,000,000</u>

This award will help complete construction of two lot expansions to remove vehicles from the SR 28 highway shoulder and connect them with a hiking trail for public use.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – State Route 227 – \$5,000,000</u> This funding will support the construction of a roundabout in Elko that will help manage traffic flow and reduce risks of vehicle collisions.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Campton Street Improvement – \$893,000</u> This project will install streetlights, a sidewalk, curbs, and gutters in downtown Ely.

<u>Town of Gardnerville – Industrial Way Reconstruction – \$1,260,000</u> This funding will help restore pavement in the Town of Gardnerville's largest Industrial Area.

<u>City of Fallon – Kaiser Road Reconstruction – \$4,900,000</u>

The City of Fallon will restore roadways and sidewalks to increase safety and access for pedestrians.

City of Sparks – Sparks Street Rehab – \$1,370,000

This project will rehabilitate roadway pavement in a residential community near Kate Smith Elementary School in Sparks.

<u>City of Reno – Solar School Zone Safety – \$1,000,000</u>

This project will support the instillation of solar-powered school zone flashers in 56 school zones to improve safety.

<u>City of Carson City – Curry Street Enhancement – \$2,600,000</u>

Carson City will use this funding to widen Curry Street to include bike lanes, pedestrian connections, street lighting, and stormwater infrastructure.

Lander County – ADA Pedestrian Access – \$2,840,000

This project will help install ADA-compliant pedestrian access facilities at Battle Mountain schools.

<u>Clark County Department of Aviation – Henderson Airport Terminal Building –</u> <u>\$2,200,000</u>

This funding will help expand the existing Henderson Executive Airport terminal building to improve the capacity and efficiency.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – High Injury Streetlight Safety –</u> <u>\$2,500,000</u>

This award will fund 3,500 upgraded streetlights in Las Vegas to improve safety for all modes of transportation in corridors where traffic incidents are high.

<u>City of North Las Vegas – Delores Huerta Resource Center – \$1,620,000</u> This award will help create a community center to provide services to the large Hispanic community in North Las Vegas.

<u>City of North Las Vegas – Fire Training Facility – \$1,000,000</u>

The City of North Las Vegas will purchase a modular structure to house a classroom and offices to train firefighters.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – I-11/SR 173/US 93 Rehabilitation –</u> \$1,000,000

This funding will rehabilitate aging pavement and upgrade existing hydraulic drainage facilities in the Henderson/Boulder City corridor to provide better resiliency during storms.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – US 95 Pavement Preservation –</u> <u>\$1,000,000</u>

This funding would improve a roadway infrastructure to support desert tortoises and their habitat and enhance driver safety.

<u>Nevada Department of Transportation – Red Rock Trail and Access – \$2,500,000</u> NDOT will construct a shared-use trail for pedestrians and bicyclists to the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Areas and implement safety improvements at nearby intersections.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada – Advanced Public</u> <u>Transit Driver Assist – \$850,000</u> This funding will support the installation of video mirrors on 425 fixed-route transit vehicles to improve road safety.

<u>Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada – Advanced Public</u> <u>Transit Driver Assist (Phase Two) – \$500,000</u>

Phase Two of the project will support the installation of video mirrors on an additional 425 fixed-route transit vehicles to improve road safety.

<u>Clark County – Lutheran Social Services of Nevada – \$1,620,000</u>

This award will help expand and construct a dining hall, commercial kitchen, and office space at a senior social services center.

City of Henderson – Prototype Park – \$500,000

This award will redevelop Wells Park in the historic Pittman neighborhood and provide a park design that addresses water conservation and sustainability.

<u>Clark County Department of Aviation – Airfield Fire and Rescue – \$1,000,000</u> This project will support improvements to bring the Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) facilities at Harry Reid International Airport up to the current safety standards.
